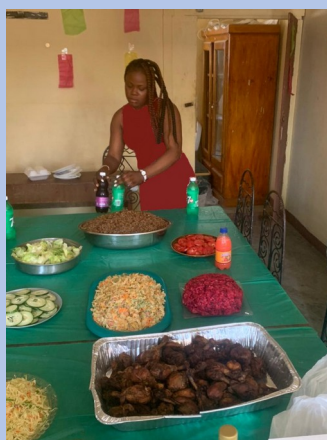

*1 Peter 4:10-11*



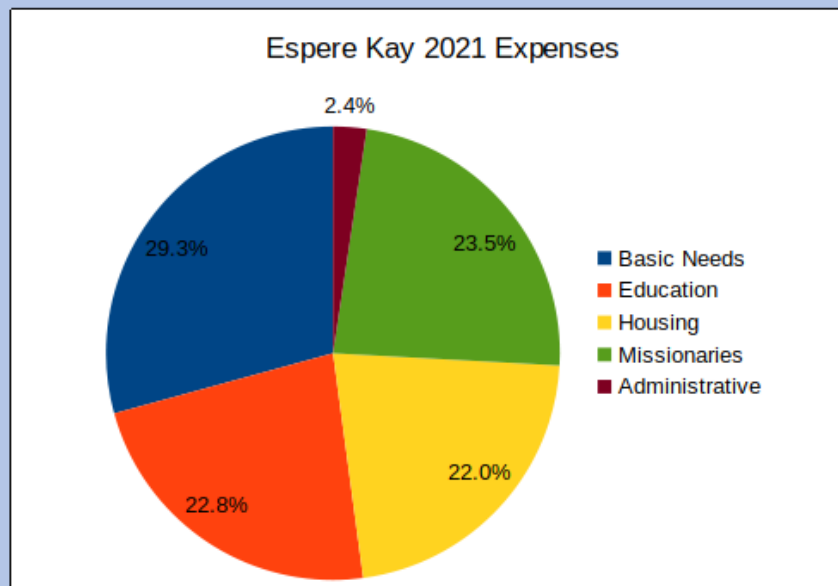
