Your donations are used to feed and clothe the children, cover medical expenses, tuitions (education in Haiti is a privilege, there is no free education; families must pay to send their children to school), staff salaries as well as miscellaneous expenses that arise.

I want to share a story with you regarding one such emergency that impacted the orphanage last month. One day, the well, which is the sole water source, stopped working. Thankfully, Osner, the orphanage director, was able to enlist the services of a well repair company who, after several weeks, located the required specialty parts needed to repair the well. We praise God that the well has been repaired and that the clinic next door shared their water supply to sustain the orphanage during this critical time. This is only one of the many ways your financial donations are used.



I am happy to report that, despite the continued unrest and gang violence throughout Haiti, the Orphanage and the children are safe and healthy. They continue to attend school and church as well as weekly visits/lessons with their English and French tutors. They are healthy and happy.
