Let me begin with the political situation in Haiti. Just when we thought the prevailing circumstances were at its worst, the gangs have taken over the airport and schools and businesses are closed. Residents are in fear of leaving their dwellings with many having already been driven from their homes. The criminal gangs are so powerful, emptying prisons and enlarging their numbers. The situation is beyond untenable with international efforts to send help having thus far gone nowhere.

Praise God the children and Osner, the orphanage director, are living in Port-au-Prince at the home of Yvette, the owner of the orphanage. The English teacher lives close by and is teaching the children on weekends while the schools are closed. Thankfully, by God's grace, the children are safe, comfortable, and have all their needs being met. Osner reports that they have all adjusted well to their new home and school.

Please continue to pray for the nation of Haiti, the children, staff and for all having to endure this nightmare.
