We are happy to share the good news with you that, despite the current conditions in Haiti, all the children from the orphanage continue to do well. Osner, the director, has informed us they are in good health with all of their needs being met. They continue to be safe at the home of Yvette, the owner of the orphanage. Yvette's nephew and his wife are living in the house and are taking care of the children. Osner lives nearby and visits as often as possible.





The children attend church and school when it is safe to pass through the streets of Port-au-Prince. On the weekends, they are receiving English instruction and soon French instruction will resume. Both tutors come to the house. We give thanks to God for His continued provision and protection for the children.

It is with sad yet thankful hearts we announce the retirement of Lucy Fraioli as our LHO Sponsorship Coordinator. Lucy has dedicated 15 years of service to the Lord in this position. Lucy was also one of the founding members of Helping Haiti's Orphans in 2014 and has served on the board as President and Director.
